Handicap limits

At the deadline of entries, the handicap limits are as followed:

Boys: ≤3,0

Girls: ≤6,0

Rules and regulations for the tournament

The competition is played under the following rules:

- The Rules of Golf 2023
- World Handicap System
- Srixon Winter Open 2025 Hard Card
- Local rules on the "Addendum to Srixon Winter Open 2025 Hard Card"

Entries

Entries will only be accepted in GolfBox.

The deadline for entry is Wednesday 5. February 2025, at 12.00 am.

The list of qualified players, and reserve lists, will be published during the next day after the deadline of entries.

Late entries will be accepted if the field (a total of 84 players) is not full. After that, a late entry will be placed at the bottom of the reserve list.

Registration

All qualified players must register their entry, no later than 12. February at 12.00 am.

Norwegian players must pay the entry fee in GolfBox. Players who fail to register before this deadline, will be deleted from the entry list and substituted by players from the reserve list.

International players will receive payment details directly from Premiumreiser. Players who fail to register before this deadline, will be deleted from the entry list and substituted by players from the reserve list.

Refunds Following Withdrawal

Any questions regarding refunds must be done directly to Premiumreiser.

Cancellation Policy:

- More than 30 days: 100% refund
- 15 to 30 days: 75% refund
- 8 to 14 days: 50% refund
- 7 days or less: No refund





Announcements

Announcements during the tournament will be posted on the Facebook page "<u>Srixon Winter Open</u> <u>2025</u>", and on the Norwegian Golf Federation's website for the tournament (Srixon Winter Open 2025). All players are responsible for checking these channels for information.

Additional Local Rules

Any additional local rules will be published as "Addendum to Srixon Winter Open 2025 Hard Card" prior to the first day of the competition. The addendum can be changed between each competition round, and any changes will bed announced on the Srixon Winter

Starting List

Starting list for round 1 and 2 will be published in GolfBox, no later than 12.00 am, the day before the first round.

Stand-by Reserve

A player who is on the reserve list may contact the Committee prior to the first round. If more than one stand-by reserve is present at the golf course, they will be ranked by the reserve list.

How ties will be Decided

Competition Cancelled or Altered

The Committee reserves the right to cancel any rounds, stop or postpone play, cancel the Tournament or come to an equitable decision to achieve a result.

Alcohol Ban

There is a general alcohol ban for all participants in the Srixon Winter Open 2025. Any violation of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from the event and the venue at the participant's own expense.

Travel Leader

Each participant in the Srixon Winter Open must have a travel leader for the duration of their stay. A travel leader is defined as an adult who is not participating in the Srixon Winter Open and who can act as a contact and responsible person in case of any issues. The contact person must be provided at the time of registration. The requirement for a travel manager applies to all players, regardless of age. If a travel leader is not specified during registration, the registration will be canceled.

Category 4:	Srixon Tour OoM 2024 U15	up to 20 players
Category 5:	Handicap	up to 24 players

If there is not a full field in one class, the remaining spots go to the other class.

Reserve lists are ranked by category 2, then category 3, then category 4.
